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ERFAL in short...

The project "ERFAL: Exchange of practices for disadvantaged people" aims to establish a thematic network at European level in order to share experience on different topics in the area of integration of disadvantaged people. The project is developing a collection of good practices dealing with the integration of migrants, disabled people, NEETs and elderly in order to provide successful models for raising their skills and supporting their economic and social integration.

The good practices will be shared with stakeholders at local, regional, national and European level aiming at improving the quality of the educational opportunities offered to those groups of disadvantaged people.

The project is funded under the Erasmus+ programme for the period 2017-2019.

ERFAL aims to...

- establish a thematic network for sharing experience on different topics in the area of integration of disadvantage people
- improve the quality of the educational opportunities offered to disadvantaged people and raise their skill levels in a wide variety of sectors
- develop a specific methodological toolbox with a selection of tools for integration of disadvantage people

The meeting was also used for the organisation of the first transnational BarCamp workshop with the topic "Integration of migrants and refugees".
